



St. Austin Catholic Parish Parking Policy

For all parishioners, visitors and
St. Austin School families

There is NO PARKING in the following areas, and you may be towed or ticketed if you park in these areas:

- Reserved spaces under the Parish Center/Gym.
 - All these spaces are reserved for parish and school staff from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.
 - The southernmost row of spaces, parallel to the driveway, is reserved for priests at all times.
- Designated disabled space without a legal disabled parking placard. This is a criminal offense. If ticketed, you can be fined and may receive jail time.
- Within the blacktop on weekends. To insure the safety of all parishioners and children on campus, parking within the blacktop is not allowed on the weekends.
- Driving lanes – DO NOT block the lanes of traffic into and out of our parking areas and alley. This includes:
 - In front of the gates into the blacktop.
 - Parallel to the north curb of the pecan tree/perpendicular to the other slots (this is a designated fire lane).
 - Parallel to our buildings along the alley.

In addition, you may be towed if you...

- Park behind the church Monday through Friday, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., without registering your vehicle with the school or parish office.
- Park your vehicle behind the church and leave St. Austin's campus.
- Park in any location that is not a designated parking spot.

We encourage everyone to take advantage of parking safely in our parking facility at 500 W. MLK Blvd. **Parking is free for those attending weekend and holy day Masses, as well as parish meetings and events.** The garage is always open for weekend Masses. Tokens to exit the garage at other times are available to those who are on campus for parish meetings and events. You can receive tokens by presenting the parking ticket you receive upon entering the garage to your ministry leader or the receptionist before you leave.
